Minimalists and 'stasis': La Monte Young, Terry Riley, Steve Reich, Philip Glass and John Adams – process triumphant: “I start the Machine and let it run...”



This lecture will deal with one of the most influential recent compositional ‘schools’: minimalism. These composers turned their backs on their contemporary ‘academic’ composers, who were primarily serialists, as well as the aleatoric school, and were instead inspired by the ‘Minimalist’ painters of New York who preceded them by almost 10 years.










